

Technical Requirements for CMS access

Browsers

Supported browsers that can be used for access to the DAMAS IFA system are Internet Explorer of version 6 or higher, and Mozilla Firefox of version 3 or higher.

DAMAS IFA system is designed to work in frames, so some keyboard shortcuts are forbidden - it could log off the user. These are for example shortcuts that perform Back action (for example Backspace, Alt + left arrow) and Reload action (Ctrl + R).

Browser's settings – in order to allow standard functioning of Damas, the basic (resp. default factory) settings shall be applied on the browser used to access Dama

Restrictions of Mozilla Firefox

- Click on “End” icon does not activate popup window to allow to accept closing of application. The browser window may be closed using the "close window" icon at the top-right corner of window.
- When the user is working concurrently in several browser windows, these windows share one identical session. If the user takes one action within one browser window, this action is taken into account for the session as a whole. Thus, if the user takes another action in another browser window, the behaviour of the system will reflect the previous action taken in the first browser window (as across both windows, the same session is shared). This is a general feature, and the user needs to take this into account, while working with Damas system through Firefox Mozilla.

System requirements

- Potential specific settings of the operation system – certain specific settings, company internal network settings, antivirus, antispam or firewall settings may prevent Damas from functioning correctly.
- Requirements for connection speed – the user shall have stable connection to the Internet. The used speed shall be sufficient to browse through web-pages fluently
- Users are hereby reminded that a slow response of the system is not necessarily a problem with Damas. Contributing factors may e.g. be as follows:
 - installed anti-virus or anti-spam program running on the computer
 - number of other user installed applications running on the computer
 - user installed plug-ins for the browser used to access Damas
 - actual speed of the local network
 - settings and limitations on the local network infrastructure
 - actual speed of Internet connection
