The data shown above is published as part of Phase 3 of the DTI Information Initiative. Deliverability is the daily maximum capability to flow gas from all sources of supply connected to the NTS, including Beach Terminals, Storage Facilities and Interconnectors. The published deliverability is adjusted for planned maintenance notified to National Grid, the figures show the 2nd lowest daily deliverability in each week.

The maximum deliverability figures are derived as follows:

- UKCS supplies based on the TBE analysis
- Langed, Bacton and BBL Interconnectors based on the notified 'nameplate' capacity for the pipeline
- Storage and LNG Imports based on the notified maximum physical deliverability for the facility

All new supplies and storage facilities due to be commissioned during the period of this table will be included with zero availability for the entire period until they are commissioned.
