National Grid has made a donation of £7,200 to Bramham Parish Council to help fund improvement works at the Pavilion.

The donation has been used to create a new hard-standing area, supply new hedging and create a footpath, amongst over improvements. A focal point of the community the pavilion is used by football clubs, Bramham school and community groups for events, classes, matches and children's playgroups and parties.

Mark Brennan from National Grid said: "We are delighted to help fund the improvements to the Bramham Pavilion. As a responsible business, we're proud to support the communities where we are working and hope to see the pavilion make a real difference to the communities for years to come."

National Grid's donation follows recent major works on the overhead line between the village of Scotton in Knaresborough and Bramham. The line was built in 1963 and has never been refurbished. Whilst pylons will last for around 80 years, the fixtures, fittings and conductors (wires) usually have to be replaced at least once during their lifespan

#### Notes to Editors:

National Grid is pivotal to the energy systems in the UK and the north eastern United States. We aim to serve customers well and efficiently, supporting the communities in which we operate and making possible the energy systems of the future.

#### National Grid in the UK:

- We own and operate the electricity transmission network in England and Wales, with day-to-day responsibility for balancing supply and demand. We also operate, but do not own, the Scottish networks. Our networks comprise approximately 7,200 kilometres (4,474 miles) of overhead line, 1,500 kilometres (932 miles) of underground cable and 342 substations.
- We own and operate the gas National Transmission System in Great Britain, with day-to-day responsibility for balancing supply and demand. Our network comprises approximately 7,660 kilometres (4,760 miles) of high-pressure pipe and 618 above-ground installations.
- As Great Britain's System Operator (SO) we make sure gas and electricity is transported safely and efficiently from where it is produced to where it is consumed. From April 2019, Electricity System Operator (ESO) is a new standalone business within National Grid, legally separate from all other parts of the National Grid Group. This will provide the right environment to deliver a balanced and impartial ESO that can realise real benefits for consumers as we transition to a more decentralised, decarbonised electricity system.
- · Other UK activities mainly relate to businesses operating in competitive markets outside of our core regulated businesses; including interconnectors, gas metering activities and a liquefied natural gas (LNG) importation terminal - all of which are now part of National Grid Ventures. National Grid Property is responsible for the management, clean-up and disposal of surplus sites in the UK. Most of these are former gas works.
