In December 2020 Winscombe Lawn Tennis club was awarded a grant of £20,000 to resurface two of their six courts.

They were last resurfaced ten years ago and were very worn and potentially dangerous when wet. Now completed, the new courts have a 10-15 year life expectancy.

This work has greatly benefited their members and the wider community. The club are supported by a passionate committee who wish to grow the membership and improve their facilities. They pride themselves on providing a social and inclusive atmosphere so not only do they promote physical wellbeing but also mental and social wellbeing.

Being able to safely open their two courts to their members, alongside members of the public has enabled them to achieve their ambition of providing an environment for their local community to stay healthy.
