<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 9.3.3 9.3.5 and 9.3.6 9.3.7(a) 9.3.7(b) 9.3.8 – 9.3.9 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In SpC 9.3.3, this paragraph should also clarify that a report on Evaluative PCDs must also be sent to the Authority by 31 July 2026 (I.e. after the end of the price control period) in respect of PCDs with delivery dates in regulatory year 2025/26. In SpC 9.3.5 and 9.3.6, insert "the" in front of "PCD" In SpC 9.3.7(a) "... how the licensee must prepare its applications" is unclear drafting. We suggest "<u>requirements and guidance relating to the reports required...</u>". In SpC 9.3.7(b), we suggest (b)(i) and (ii) are amended to read (i) "whether to direct a reduction to allowances for the Evaluative PCDs that have not been Fully Delivered; and (ii) the value of any reduction to be directed." In SpC 9.3.8 and SpC 9.3.9 there is considerable duplication in these two paragraphs and we suggest that they are merged as one: "<i>Before issuing or amending the PCD Reporting Requirements and Methodology Document by direction, the Authority will publish on the Authority's Website: (a) the text of the proposed PCD Reporting Requirements and Methodology Document; (b) the date on which the Authority intends the proposed PCD Reporting</i>
