## 2. Driver Summary

The current welfare and office facilities at Tottenham are inadequate and antiquated. Modern ways of working require better office facilities.			
The existing welfare unit was constructed in the 1960s, before being extended in the late 2000s with 2 Portakabin units. The current office accommodation is in a cramped arrangement of traditional build offices with modular buildings tacked on to the side. There are numerous defects in both types of building and the layout and construction does not lend itself to modernisation/alteration. It is now found to be in an overall poor condition, with the building suffering from extensive structural cracking and wateringress through the roof. There is poor abundance of natural light into the building, with no formal meeting place and no provisions for disabled persons.			
This project aims to provide a new modular welfare/office building located on the site of the existing buildings.
