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Executive Summary

- Ex1.0.1 This Appendix contains the UKHO and other heritage records identified within the Study Area by the Marine Archaeology baseline assessment within **Volume 1, Part 3, Chapter 26: Marine Archaeology**.
- Ex1.0.2 The UKHO records are presented first with detailed descriptions derived from the UKHO entry. The gazetteer table is subsequently presented. The gazetteer for heritage records (NRHE, HER and CITiZAN) is presented thereafter.

3.26.B. Gazetteer of UKHO and Heritage Records

3.26.B.1 UKHO records within the Study Area

W_001

3.26.B.1.1 W_001 (UKHO ID: 103434) represents a dangerous, unknown wreck, first recorded on 19 February 2024 in general water depth of 19 m. The sonar dimensions are given as 8.58 m (L) by 3.03 m (W) by 0.6 m (H). W_001 directly corresponds with medium potential geophysical anomaly EGL4_885.

W_002

3.26.B.1.2 W_002 (UKHO ID: 4491) represents the wreck of the *Choice*, a British-flagged trawler built in 1892 and lost on 20 August 1903. The non-dangerous wreck is recorded intact, upright, with bows to southwest and sonar measurements of 33.8 m (L) by 8.48 m (W) by 5.7 m (H), in waters generally 66 m deep. Scour is recorded at the bow and stern.

W_003

3.26.B.1.3 W_003 (UKHO ID: 4560) represents an unknown, non-dangerous, possible wreck, first identified in April 1974 and last in 1988. Although noted as identified by sonar, only a length dimension (21.3 m) is provided by the UKHO record. The UKHO also record this position as 'dead'.

W_004

3.26.B.1.4 W_004 (UKHO ID: 4565) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_005

3.26.B.1.5 W_005 (UKHO ID: 4600) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_006

3.26.B.1.6 W_006 (UKHO ID: 4609) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_007

3.26.B.1.7 W_007 (UKHO ID: 4612) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

3.26.B.1.8 W_008 (UKHO ID: 4613) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_009

3.26.B.1.9 W_009 (UKHO ID: 4614) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_010

3.26.B.1.10 W_010 (UKHO ID: 4619) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_011

3.26.B.1.11 W_011 (UKHO ID: 4625) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1971 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_012

3.26.B.1.12 W_012 (UKHO ID: 4629) represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Rameses*, a British-flagged trawler captured and destroyed by a submarine on 18 April 1917 and last detected in 2005. The UKHO record the position as 'dead' and no measurements are provided. The water depth at this position is given as 60 m.

W_013

3.26.B.1.13 W_013 (UKHO ID: 4633) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1982 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_014

3.26.B.1.14 W_014 (UKHO ID: 4636) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1982 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_015

3.26.B.1.15 W_015 (UKHO ID: 4659) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1982 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_016

3.26.B.1.16 W_016 (UKHO ID: 4662) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1982 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_017

3.26.B.1.17 W_017 (UKHO ID: 4665) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1982 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

3.26.B.1.18 W_018 (UKHO ID: 4671) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1982 and last in 2009, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_019

3.26.B.1.19 W_019 (UKHO ID: 6205) represents an unknown, non-dangerous wreck, identified in 1988. The wreck is recorded as 'broken', measuring (on sonar) 80 m (L) by 13 m (W) by 8.9 m (H) in general water depths of 71 m.

W_020

3.26.B.1.20 W_020 (UKHO ID: 6384) represents an unknown, non-dangerous wreck, identified in 1988. The wreck is recorded as intact, measuring (on sonar) 32 m (L) by 4 m (W) by 4 m (H) in general water depths of 73 m.

W_021

3.26.B.1.21 W_021 (UKHO ID: 6385) represents an unknown, non-dangerous wreck, identified in 1988. The wreck is recorded as intact, measuring (on sonar) 25 m (L) by 6 m (W) by 2.9 m (H) in general water depths of 81 m.

W_022

- 3.26.B.1.22 W_022 (UKHO ID: 6464) represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Cynthia*, a British-flagged trawler built in 1891 and lost on 24 September 1916, measuring 29.4 m (L) by 7.1 m (W) by 3.2 m (H) (not sonar).
- 3.26.B.1.23 The wreck is recorded as last detected in 1986, however, it is also recorded as 'dead' and noted that the position was originally provided for filing only. The water depth at this position is given as 46 m.

W_023

- 3.26.B.1.24 W_023 (UKHO ID: 6487) represents the wreck of the *Joseph and William*, a British-flagged sailing vessel built in 1869 and foundered on 15 October 1884, sinking c. 18 miles east of Flamborough Head. No vessel measurements (sonar or otherwise) are given.
- 3.26.B.1.25 The wreck is recorded as last detected in 1987, however, it is also recorded as 'dead' and noted that the position was originally provided for filing only. Water depth at this position is given as 51 m.

W_024

3.26.B.1.26 W_024 (UKHO ID: 6488) relates to the wreck of the *Aphelion*, a British-flagged trawler built in 1899 and lost on 24 September 1916 in same position as W_025. The vessel measured 33.7 m (L) by 6.5 m (W) by 3.4 m (H) and the UKHO record the position as 'dead'.

W_025

3.26.B.1.27 W_025 (UKHO ID: 6489) relates to the wreck of the *Albatross*, a British-flagged trawler built in 1897 and lost on 24th September 1916 in same position as W_024. The vessel measured 30.5 m (L) by 6.2 m (W) by 3.4 m (H) and the UKHO record the position as 'dead'.

3.26.B.1.28 W_026 (UKHO ID: 6516) relates to an unknown, non-dangerous wreck, approximately positioned in 1917 or 1929. The latest detection is recorded as 1997, however, no measurements are given and the UKHO record the position as 'dead'.

W_027

- 3.26.B.1.29 W_027 (UKHO ID: 6524) represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Condor*, a British-flagged trawler mined and sunk c. 30 miles northeast from Scarborough on 29 May 1915. The wreck is recorded as intact in general water depth of 67 m, with sonar measurements of 65 m (L) by 10 m (W) by 7 m (H).
- 3.26.B.1.30 The wreck was last detected in 1994.

W_028

3.26.B.1.31 W_028 (UKHO ID: 6528) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1972 and last in 1993, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_029

3.26.B.1.32 W_029 (UKHO ID: 6529) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1972 and last in 1993, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_030

3.26.B.1.33 W_030 (UKHO ID: 6530) represents a foul ground record or 'Fisherman's Fastener'. First detected in January 1972 and last in 1993, the position is now recorded as 'dead'.

W_031

3.26.B.1.34 W_031 (UKHO ID: 6532) possibly represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Johnny Boy*, a Danish-flagged, wooden hulled fishing vessel. The vessel took on water and sunk after being abandoned on 14 July 1976 and is recorded as intact and upright, with sonar measurements of 40 m (L) by 10 m (W) by 5.6 m (H), in water depths of 63 m.

W_032

3.26.B.1.35 W_032 (UKHO ID: 6549) represents an unknown, non-dangerous wreck first detected in 1976 with no reported subsequent detections. No measurements are given, and the position lies in water depths of 69 m

W_033

3.26.B.1.36 W_033 (UKHO ID: 6557) represents an unknown, non-dangerous wreck, first detected in 1980 and last in 1997 in waters 57 m deep. No measurements are given and the UKHO record the position as 'dead'.

W_034

3.26.B.1.37 W_034 (UKHO ID: 6597) possibly represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Kieldrecht*, a British-flagged steam ship, built in 1916 and lost on 15 June 1918 *c*. 18 miles east of Flamborough Head.

3.26.B.1.38 The wreck was last detected in 1987 in waters 51 m deep, with sonar measurements of 80 m (L) by 12 m (W) by 5.5 m (H).

W_035

3.26.B.1.39 W_035 (UKHO ID: 6603) represents an unknown, non-dangerous wreck first detected in 1981 and last in 2009 in waters 45 m deep. The wreck is recorded as having its bows to the southeast, port side collapsed midships and with sonar measurements of 27 m (L) by 7 m (W) by 2.7 m (H).

W_036

- 3.26.B.1.40 W_036 (UKHO ID: 6619) is related to the *Renate S*, a fishing vessel without country of registration recorded by the UKHO, reported missing on 15 September 1983. This record relates to the reported sinking and is noted as both 'non-dangerous' and 'dead' by the UKHO.
- 3.26.B.1.41 Related records are W_037, *c*. 2.9 km to the north (see below) and UKHO record 6706, *c*. 3.9 km to the northeast (beyond the Study Area). The latter record describes an intact, non-dangerous wreck in this position (outside of the Study Area) in waters depths of 60 m, identified using an acoustic sensor and providing sonar measurements of 60 m (L) by 15 m (W) by 6.5 m (H).

W_037

- 3.26.B.1.42 W_037 (UKHO ID: 6620) is also related to the *Renate S*, specifically to a diver sighting made and identifying the vessel in 1984. The vessel's measurements are given as 59.7 m (L) by 8.8 m (W) by 3.4 m (H) (not sonar), in waters 58 m deep.
- 3.26.B.1.43 This UKHO record is noted as both 'non-dangerous' and 'dead'. See also W_036.

W_038

3.26.B.1.44 W_038 (UKHO ID: 6635) relates to foul ground detected in 1997. With sonar measurements of 6 m (L) by 5 m (W) by 0.5 m (H), the position is tentatively interpreted as a boulder or debris.

W_039

3.26.B.1.45 W_039 (UKHO ID: 6640) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_040

3.26.B.1.46 W_040 (UKHO ID: 6652) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_041

3.26.B.1.47 W_041 (UKHO ID: 6655) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_042

3.26.B.1.48 W_042 (UKHO ID: 6666) represents a non-dangerous wreck first identified in 1986 and last in 1997, in waters 58 m deep. It is recorded as intact, probably laying on its side, with sonar measurements of 30 m (L) by 12 m (W) by 4.7 m (H). W_042 directly corresponds with high potential geophysical anomaly EGL3_240.

3.26.B.1.49 W_043 (UKHO ID: 6672) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_044

3.26.B.1.50 W_044 (UKHO ID: 6673) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_045

3.26.B.1.51 W_045 (UKHO ID: 6678) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_046

3.26.B.1.52 W_046 (UKHO ID: 6681) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_047

3.26.B.1.53 W_047 (UKHO ID: 6682) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_048

3.26.B.1.54 W_048 (UKHO ID: 6683) relates to foul ground detected in 1986. The position is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_049

3.26.B.1.55 W_049 (UKHO ID: 6688) represents a non-dangerous wreck first detected in 1987 in waters 53 m deep. The wreck is recorded as upright and intact, with sonar measurements of 34 m (L) by 12 m (W) by 4.5 m (H).

W_050

3.26.B.1.56 W_050 (UKHO ID: 6715) represents the non-dangerous wreck of a sailing vessel, first detected in 1997 in waters 65 m deep. The wreck is described as in two parts, with the bows pointed towards the rear half, measuring on sonar 27 m (L) by 5 m (W) by 3 m (H).

W_051

3.26.B.1.57 W_051 (UKHO ID: 6717) represents a pile of fishing gear (nets and ropes) first detected in 1997. The obstruction is measured as 6.7 m (L) by 4 m (W) by 1.2 m (H), in waters 64 m deep.

W_052

- 3.26.B.1.58 W_052 (UKHO ID: 8637) represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Star*, a British-flagged sailing vessel lost following a collision on 5 September 1895. The sinking position is given as 17 miles south-southeast of Spurn Head, however, it is noted in the UKHO record that this position is for filing only and it considered 'dead'.
- 3.26.B.1.59 The position is in water depths of 11 m and no vessel measurements are given.

3.26.B.1.60 W_053 (UKHO ID: 8640) represents a dangerous wreck in waters 10 m deep. The circumstances of the sinking are not recorded by the UKHO, however, the wreck is recorded as lifted and the position for filing only. It is unclear when the wreck was lifted, as the date of first detection is given as 1923 and last as 2014.

W_054

- 3.26.B.1.61 W_054 (UKHO ID: 8661) represents the dangerous wreck of the HMS Corfield, a British-flagged steam ship built in 1937 purchased by the Admiralty for use as a minesweeper and lost to a mine on 8 September 1941. The fragmented wreck lies in waters 9 m deep and has sonar measurements of 80 m (L) by 55 m (W) by 1 m (H).
- 3.26.B.1.62 A debris field entirely within scour is noted around the wreck, although it is not clear if the above measurements include this.

W_055

- 3.26.B.1.63 W_055 (UKHO ID: 8664) represents the wreck of the *Lizzie Carter*, a Britishflagged, wooden sailing vessel lost following a collision on 9 April 1896. The UKHO record notes that the vessel was built in 1897, which may be the actual year of loss.
- 3.26.B.1.64 The UKHO record the wreck as dangerous, although it is also recorded as a position for filing only and a 'dead' position. No measurements are given though the last detection is recorded as 1993, in waters 9 m deep.

W_056

3.26.B.1.65 W_056 (UKHO ID: 8667) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Fryken*, a Swedish-flagged steam ship built in 1905 and lost on 9 July 1918. The wreck lies in waters 10 m deep and is noted as a navigational hazard, with sonar measurements of 66 m (L) by 14 m (W) by 1 m (H).

W_057

3.26.B.1.66 W_057 (UKHO ID: 8676) possibly represents part of the *Ravonia*, a steam ship of unrecorded registration lost on 24 September 1944. The dangerous wreckage at this position lies in waters 11 m deep, with sonar measurements of 83 m (L) by 23 m (W) by 2.8 m (H).

W_058

3.26.B.1.67 W_058 (UKHO ID: 8678) also relates to the *Ravonia*, likely a detached part of wreckage, measuring 11 m (L) by 7 m (W) by 0.6 m (H). See also W_057.

W_059

3.26.B.1.68 W_059 (UKHO ID: 8691) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Beelsby*, a British-flagged, wooden sailing vessel built in 1888 and lost following a collision on 6 August 1890. The position is noted as for filing only and recorded as 'dead'. No measurements are given though the last detection is recorded as 1993, in waters 12 m deep.

- 3.26.B.1.69 W_060 (UKHO ID: 8726) possibly represents the dangerous wreck of the *Schieland*, a Dutch-flagged steam ship sunk on 1 April 1915. The wreck is recorded as upright with detached bows in waters 19 m deep, with sonar measurements of 102 m (L) by 25 m (W) by 6 m (H).
- 3.26.B.1.70 A separate record (W_091; see below), situated *c*. 4 km to the southwest, is also related to the *Schieland* and is noted as lifted.

W_061

3.26.B.1.71 W_061 (UKHO ID: 8730) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Stylianos Chandris*, a Greek-flagged steam ship built in 1919 and lost on 22 December 1941, in waters 15 m deep. The wreck is described as broken into two main sections within scour, with sonar measurements of 80 m (L) by 40 m (W) by 1.5 m (H).

W_062

- 3.26.B.1.72 W_062 (UKHO ID: 8759) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Lancaster*, a British-flagged trawler lost following a collision on 12 April 1905. The position is recorded as 'dead' and for filing only. No measurements are provided.
- 3.26.B.1.73 See also W_075 (c. 3.33 km to the southwest).

W_063

3.26.B.1.74 W_063 (UKHO ID: 8842) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Virginian*, a British-flagged trawler built in 1906 and lost on 5 November 1946. The wreck lies in waters 32 m deep and sonar measurements are given as 21.7 m (L) by 6 m (W) by 4.8 m (H).

W_064

3.26.B.1.75 W_064 (UKHO ID: 8852) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Royston*, a British-flagged steam ship built in 1919 and lost on 5 May 1941. The wreck is recorded as broken midships with deep scours close to the east in waters 21 m deep, measuring on sonar 101 m (L) by 40 m (W) by 4 m (H).

W_065

- 3.26.B.1.76 W_065 (UKHO ID: 8854) possibly represents the wreck of the *Scotia*, a Britishflagged trawler lost on 13 December 1918 following a collision. The dangerous wreck is recorded by sonar as measuring 24.49 m (L) by 6.5 m (W) by 2.4 m (H), in water 27 m deep.
- 3.26.B.1.77 See also W_087 for a further possible location of this vessel (*c*. 4.55 km to the southeast).

W_066

3.26.B.1.78 W_066 (UKHO ID: 8856) possibly represents the reck of the *Cecil*, a Britishflagged sailing vessel, lost on 27 October 1897 following a collision. The dangerous wreck is almost fully buried, measuring on sonar 1.45 m (H) (no length or width measurements recorded), in waters 24 m deep.

3.26.B.1.79 W_067 (UKHO ID: 8858) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Silver Queen*, a British-flagged sailing vessel lost on 4 March 1894 after colliding with floating wreckage. The position lies in waters 22 m deep, however, no measurements of the wreck are given. The UKHO further note this as a 'dead' position.

W_068

3.26.B.1.80 W_068 (UKHO ID: 8860) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Catford*, a British-flagged steam ship built in 1919 and lost on 31 May 1943. The wreck is recorded as upright and very broken up midships, measuring on sonar 79 m (L) by 25.5 m (W) by 4.4 m (H), in waters 25 m deep.

W_069

3.26.B.1.81 W_069 (UKHO ID: 8868) represents the dangerous wreck of the *Norfolk*, a Britishflagged sailing vessel lost on 7 April 1892 following a collision. The wreck is recorded in two parts, measuring on sonar 94 m (L) by 25 m (W) by 4.6 m (H), in water 25 m deep.

W_070

3.26.B.1.82 W_070 (UKHO ID: 8874) represents the dangerous wreck of an unknown sailing vessel, identified in 1940 and examined in 1982 in water depths of 25 m. The wreck measures 49.8 m (L) by 30.9 m (W) by 3.13 m (H) on sonar.

W_071

3.26.B.1.83 W_071 (UKHO ID: 8903) possibly represents the dangerous wreck of the *Larchwood*, a British-flagged steam ship built in 1924 and lost on 27 January 1932. The wreck is described as intact, measuring on sonar 45 m (L) by 5 m (H) (no width measurement is given), in waters 25 m deep.

W_072

3.26.B.1.84 W_072 (UKHO ID: 8913) represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Ajax*, a British-flagged trawler lost on 2 September 1914. No measurements are given and the position, in waters 29 m deep, is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_073

3.26.B.1.85 W_073 (UKHO ID: 8918) probably represents the dangerous wreck of the *Rebono*, a British-flagged trawler lost on 23 September 1914. The wreck is described as well-defined and intact, measuring on sonar 55 m (L) by 8 m (W) by 3.7 m (H), in waters 32 m deep.

W_074

3.26.B.1.86 W_074 (UKHO ID: 8953) possibly represents the non-dangerous wreck of the *Rochester*, a British-flagged trawler built in 1898 and lost on 27 July 1944. The wreck lies in waters 39 m deep and sonar measurements of 28 m (L) by 7 m (W) by 1 m (H) are given.

W_075

3.26.B.1.87 W_075 (UKHO ID: 8994) possibly represents the dangerous wreck of the *Lancaster*, a British-flagged trawler lost on 12 April 1905 following a collision. The wreck lies in waters 14 m deep and is given sonar measurements of 44 m (L) by 13 m (W) by 3.4 m (H).

3.26.B.1.88 See also W_062 (c. 3.33 km to the northeast).

W_076

3.26.B.1.89 W_076 (UKHO ID: 8995) represents a non-dangerous wreck identified in February 1980. No measurements are given and the position, in waters 12 m deep, is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_077

3.26.B.1.90 W_077 (UKHO ID: 8997) represents a non-dangerous wreck identified in February 1980. No measurements are given and the position, in waters 10 m deep, is recorded by the UKHO as 'dead'.

W_078

3.26.B.1.91 W_078 (UKHO ID: 9030) represents the dangerous wreck of an unidentified, steel hulled trawler detected in June 1981. The wreck lies in waters 25 m deep and is given sonar measurements of 30.2 m (L) by 12.4 m (W) by 2.36 m (H).

W_079

3.26.B.1.92 W_079 (UKHO ID: 9040) represents the dangerous wreck of an unidentified steam ship detected in July 1982. The intact wreck lies on its starboard side in waters 25 m deep and is given sonar measurements of 52 m (L) by 8.5 m (H) (no width measurement is given).

W_080

3.26.B.1.93 W_080 (UKHO ID: 9041) represents the dangerous wreck of an unidentified trawler detected in July 1982. The poorly defined wreck lies in waters 25 m deep and is given sonar measurements of 20 m (L) by 4 m (H) (no width measurement is given).

W_081

3.26.B.1.94 W_081 (UKHO ID: 9043) represents a foul ground position, measuring 80 m (L) by 30 m (W) by 1 m (H), detected in November 1983. The position lies in water 28 m deep and comprises a spread of debris and single wreck fragment.

W_082

3.26.B.1.95 W_082 (UKHO ID: 9067) represents a small, linear acoustic contact, first detected in July 1988 in waters 30 m deep. Sonar measurements of 6.5 m (L) by 2 m (W) by 1 m (H) are given and the UKHO record the position as 'dead'.

W_083

3.26.B.1.96 W_084 (UKHO ID: 9074) represents a non-dangerous, possible wreck, first detected in December 1989 in waters 8 m deep. Sonar measurements of 30 m (L) by 1.5 m (H) are given (no width measurement is recorded) and the UKHO record the position as 'dead'.

W_084

3.26.B.1.97 W_084 (UKHO ID: 9088) represents the position of a USAF F15 aircraft, ditched on 25 or 27 April 1990. It is noted that the pilot was recovered but no mention is
