In March 2023, the Tickenham Village Hall Management Committee was awarded a grant of £20,000 to support the construction of a garden room to the village hall.

The addition of a garden room provided the community of 1,000 largely elderly residents a very useful additional amenity and activity space.

The project was managed by a local villager and built entirely utilising local skills and suppliers and ensures that Tickenham Village Hall can continue to serve the village, with a facility that is fit for purpose well into the future, supporting the provision of activities and organised services which are vital to mental and physical well-being as well as community spirit.

Commenting on the funding, parish councillor Ann Loader, said,

'With the completion of the new extension, there is a level of excitement building as to the future usage of the space. Our Friday Library, Coffee and Chat and Warm space initiative will be able to provide more space for villagers to come and browse, stay and chat, and find a warm hub to rest amongst friends.'
