Re: The National Grid Electricity Transmission Plc (Grain to Tilbury) Compulsory Purchase Order 2024 ("the Order")

We set out below the steps taken by National Grid Electricity Transmission Plc ("NGET") to comply with the statutory and regulatory requirements as set out in the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act"), The Compulsory Purchase of Land (Prescribed Forms) (Ministers) Regulations 2004 (S.I. 2004 No. 2595) ("the 2004 Regulations") (as amended) and the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007 ("the 2007 Rules") (as amended).

1. We confirm that the Order has been prepared by NGET in the Form numbered 1 in the 2004 Regulations. The CPO was sealed and dated 14th November 2024.
2. Notice of Making of the CPO in the Form numbered 7 in the 2004 Regulations was published in two issues of the Thurrock Gazette and Gravesend and Dartford Messenger dated 21st November 2024 and 28th November 2024. Copies of the relevant pages from above editions the Thurrock Gazette and Gravesend and Dartford Messenger appear at **Appendix 1 and 2** of this letter. The time allowed for objections was in excess of 21 days from the first date of publication, i.e. until 20th December 2024.
3. Site Notices of the making of the Order in the Form numbered 7 in the 2004 Regulations and addressed to "Persons occupying or having an interest in the land" under section 11 of the 1981 Act were posted at conspicuous places on the Order land at locations shown and marked "General Notice [#]" on the plan at **Appendix 3** to this letter. A copy of the form of Notice appears at **Appendix 4**.
4. Notice of the Making of the Order in the Form numbered 8 in the 2004 Regulations were duly served on every owner, tenant, occupier and qualifying person in relation to all land comprised within the CPO in accordance with section 6(1) of the 1981 Act. A copy of the notice appears at **Appendix 5**. The time allowed for objections specified in each Notice was in excess of 21 days, i.e. 20th December 2024.
5. The Notices referred to in paragraph 4 above were served by First Class Tracking post on 21st November 2024. A sample letter delivering such Notices appears at **Appendix 6** to this letter. A copy of NGET's Statement of Reasons was served with each Notice.

These notices are there to inform the public and are rarely open to challenge or objection. These notices are required by law to alert people to changes and allow them to adjust their travel arrangements. They are almost always placed by Local Authorities, sometimes on behalf of other organisations. Some of the more common notices relate to Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders, Road & Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Traffic Movement and Speed Limits and the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

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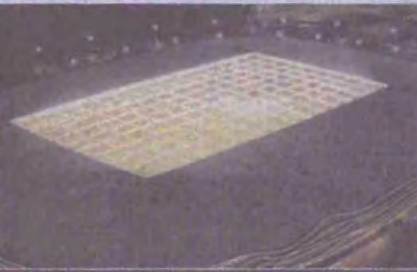

Thugs jailed after brutal home raid

Knife-wielding masked raiders subjected a family to "brutal and terrifying" violence, robbing them of £300 and three phones.

Ashley Henry and Morgan Tinteloo had been in the Robert Pocock pub in Gravesend

town centre and after phoning Marvrick Elba to pick them up, they drove to Swanscombe and terrorised their victims as they were settling down to a PlayStation game at their home on November 2 last year.

Maldstone Crown Court heard they subjected the family to a "callous, cowardly and heinous" ordeal.

One youngster was pinned down and had a knife held against their neck.

When the trio's demands were not met, Henry repeatedly hit the father with a 10kg dumbbell, leaving him with multiple, life-threatening fractures to his skull, eye socket, cheekbone and jaw, as well as a brain injury from which he will never fully recover.

Tinteloo, of Main Road, Longfield, Henry, of Crescent Wood Road, Sydenham, south east London, and Elba, of White Road, Chatham, have now been jailed for a total of more than 43 years after admitting robbery.

Judge Saxby told them: "Let there be no doubt that this was brutal, unprovoked, and terrifying criminality."

Fly-tipping fury

Gran fined £500 for leaving bag of clothes next to full donation bin



Susan and Phil Cowdry
were shocked to receive a
£500 fine for fly-tipping.

A grandmother has been fined £500 for fly-tipping after leaving a neatly folded bag of clothes next to a full donation bin.

Susan Cowdry, of Church Road, Hartley, dropped off her and her grandchildren's clothes to a British Heart Foundation collection point near her home.

When she arrived, she saw it was full and so placed her bag by the bin which she thought would be collected soon.

But then she received a letter from Dartford council accusing her of fly-tipping and issuing a fine of £500. The 65-year-old said: "I was shocked and I went back to them and said I wasn't fly-tipping. I thought because it's full up it's probably going to be collected soon."

"I admit fly-tipping and fly-tippers. I am a responsible citizen."

Susan and her husband Phil are refusing to pay the fine.

Phil said: "The fact it's all neatly folded in a Mark bag, no thought that's as good a reason as any for it not to be considered as fly-tipping."

"I've never seen the bin empty if



The British Heart Foundation bins in Hartley Road.

They are emptying it if they are not doing it enough."

The British Heart Foundation admitted the bin was emptied fortnightly instead of weekly and has since increased the frequency of collections.

Dartford council says Susan's bin was loaded correctly and will stand.

A spokesman said: "It is sadly the case that when one bag is discarded by one person, however well-intended, it rapidly encourages further fly-tipping by people less scrupulous, leaving the council with no choice but to undertake enforcement action."

This project is an electricity infrastructure upgrade to replace the aging tunnel beneath the Thames between Tilbury and Gravesend. NGET proposes constructing a new 2.3-kilometre tunnel, installing new cabling, and building two headhouses and Cable Sealing End Compounds at each end. This upgrade is crucial for delivering cleaner, greener electricity efficiently and reliably, supporting the UK's net zero goals. It is part of the Accelerated Strategic Transmission Investment to meet the 2030 50GW offshore wind target and The Great Grid Upgrade to enhance the electricity grid and connect renewable energy sources, aligning with the Government's plan to power all homes with renewable energy by 2030.

NGET's preference will and has always been to secure land and new rights to enable construction and operation of the Project by voluntary agreement. 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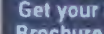

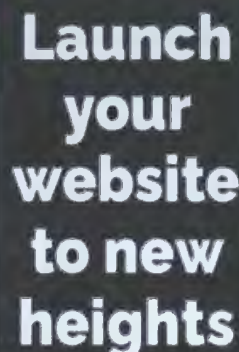

'A crime against disabled people'

Parents of disabled adults have spoken of their outrage after funding for a "life-line" day centre was slashed - leaving them to plug the gap.

Kent County Council (KCC) has cut part of its budget for the SAND centre in Princess Street, Gravesend, which is run by the National Autistic Society (NAS).

The venue offers care, support and activities for adults with autism and is jointly funded by KCC, NAS and its clients.

But the county council has changed its contract and will no longer be funding activities and transport, raising significant financial pressures.

Sarah Howes, of Singlene, whose daughter Hannah uses

the centre said it feels like because these adults are not able to speak and advocate for themselves, the council has just been whisked away from beneath them. I think that is an absolute crime and an outrage against disabled people.

Hannah had been paying £10,000 a week to the centre. It is now gone up to £15,000.

Sarah added: "It is incredibly stressful as we do not have that money to cover."

Mark Paine, of Dartford, said his son Ben was referred to the centre as he needed full filling and stimulating activities - but they could be stopped if they cannot pay for them.

"I want to make a stand about this as I think it is morally wrong," she said. "I understand KCC is in dire straits but get the money somewhere else and not from our vulnerable adults."

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
