Our Proposal

We propose to extend the existing Margam substation and connect it to a new substation on the Tata Steel site via an underground cable.

The expanded facility will include a new 275 kV substation to replace the existing one. It will also feature a Gas Insulated Switchgear (GIS) hall and a support building for site operations.

This proposal will enable the electrification of Tata Steel's electric arc furnace, strengthen the local electricity network, and allow for future connections. In doing so, it would play a key role in securing jobs in the area and support the creation of green steel.

As part of the project design, we have given consideration to reducing the impact of our project locally. This includes reducing the impact of our construction traffic. Site access will be via Cefn Gwrgan Road, with temporary construction compounds and haul roads located within the designated construction zone.

We understand the importance of this project to local communities and are hosting a public information event for those who live and work closest to the site to understand our proposals in more detail, speak to our team and ask any questions you may have. We will need planning permission for our project from Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council. Before we submit our application later this Summer, we will be holding a 28-day statutory Pre-Application Consultation (PAC) where we will share our final draft application for review and comment.

As part of this statutory Pre-Application Consultation (PAC), we are required to consult with the following three groups:

- Adjoining owners and occupiers to the application site
- Community consultees
- and Specialist consultees.

A PAC report, as required by the Planning (Wales) Act 2015, will then be submitted as part of our planning application.
