We are proposing to build a new electricity connection between Norwich and Tilbury. It will play an important part in connecting more secure, cleaner, home-grown energy from more affordable sources.

Proposed changes to our proposals

We have identified two locations where we want to make a very small change to the proposals we submitted in August. Before we confirm the changes, we will send information to local residents and ask for their feedback.

Both changes are very small and have been put forward following our ongoing discussions with landowners and stakeholders and we do not believe they introduce any significant new impacts.

Making adjustments like this after an application has been accepted for examination is a normal part of the DCO process.

Little Bromley

We are proposing a small change to the permanent access and construction access routes for the East Anglia Connection Node (EACN) substation at Little Bromley where they cross an agricultural field. The change would reduce impact on farming activities.

Bulphan

We are proposing a small change to our plans where the route of the overhead line crosses the Thames to Buncefield Multifuel Pipeline, west of Langdon Hills Golf Club to enable third party mitigation works on the existing pipeline.

We are not proposing to change the route or location of pylons in this area.

Targeted consultation

We will publish more information in the New Year when we will write to local residents and parish councils to invite them to comment on the proposed changes.
