Location reference: Moulton Seas End to South Holland Drain

Eastern Green Link 3 (EGL 3) and Eastern Green Link 4 (EGL 4) are two proposed high voltage electricity links which will run mostly undersea between Scotland and England.

We have held two stages of consultation on EGL 3 and EGL 4. The first stage of consultation took place in 2024, followed by a second in 2025.

Following the close of the Stage 2 consultation, we reviewed and considered all feedback received in order to refine our proposals. We have also continued to carry out further assessments and survey work. As a result, we have identified some additional land required to build the Projects.

We are therefore launching a new and more targeted consultation on the proposed works within this additional land. We would greatly welcome your views.

Our targeted consultation will open on **Thursday 9 April** and end on **Monday 11 May 2026**.

What we are proposing to change in this area

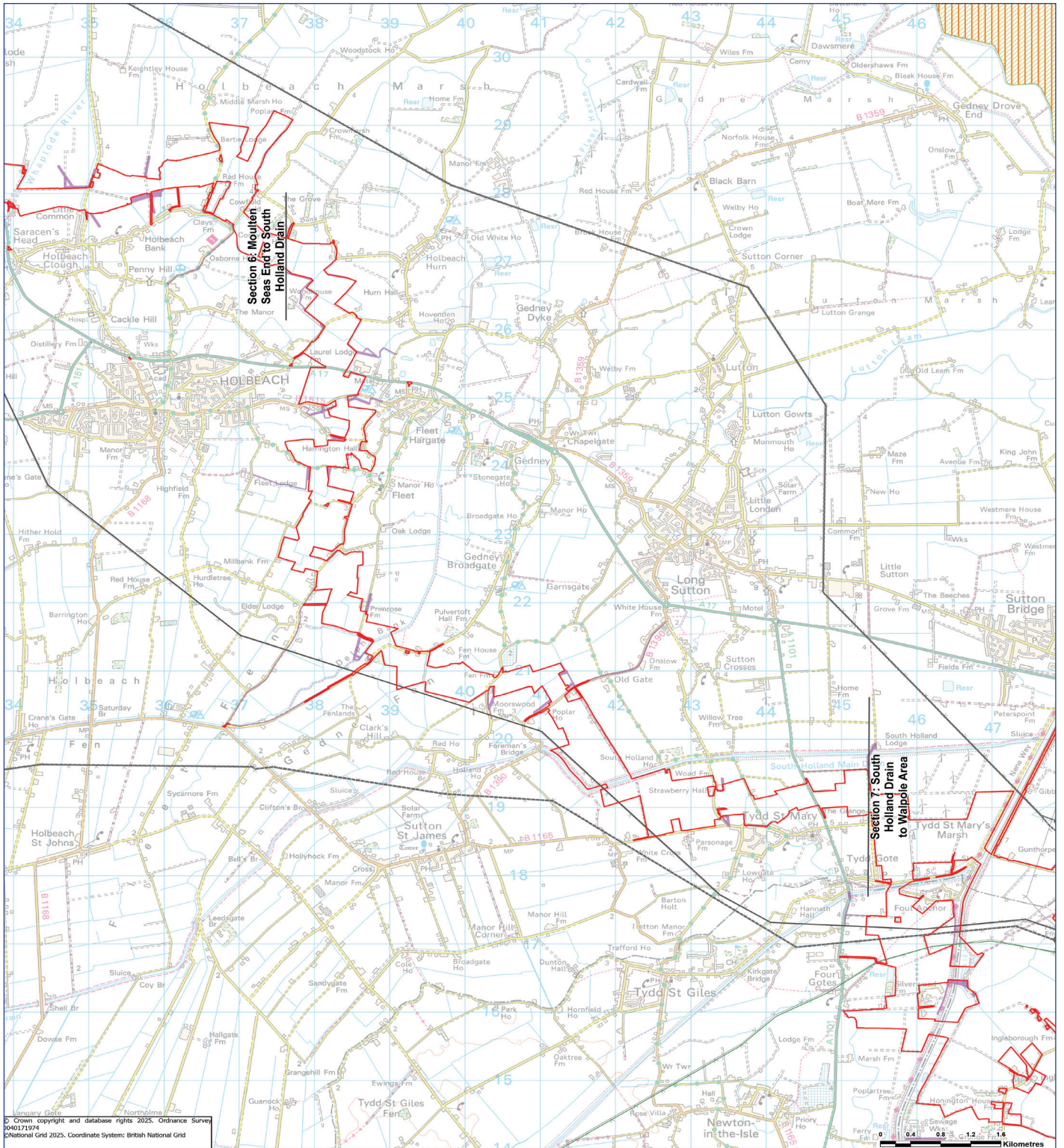
From Moulton Seas End to South Holland Drain, the newly identified land required to build EGL 3 and EGL 4 will be used:

- for works on existing electricity utilities affected during the construction phase. This will include temporary and permanent works on existing overhead lines to allow for construction access
- for highway works. This includes road widening, creation of passing bays and vegetation clearance to assist the movement of construction vehicles and the delivery of large equipment
- for the use and extension of existing access tracks to facilitate construction and future maintenance of the Projects' underground cables and surrounding area
- for the installation of temporary access tracks and haul roads
- works to the existing field and land drainage.
