TO: THE OWNERS, LESSEES AND TENANTS OF LAND SHOWN SHADED PURPLE ON THE ACCOMPANYING PLAN

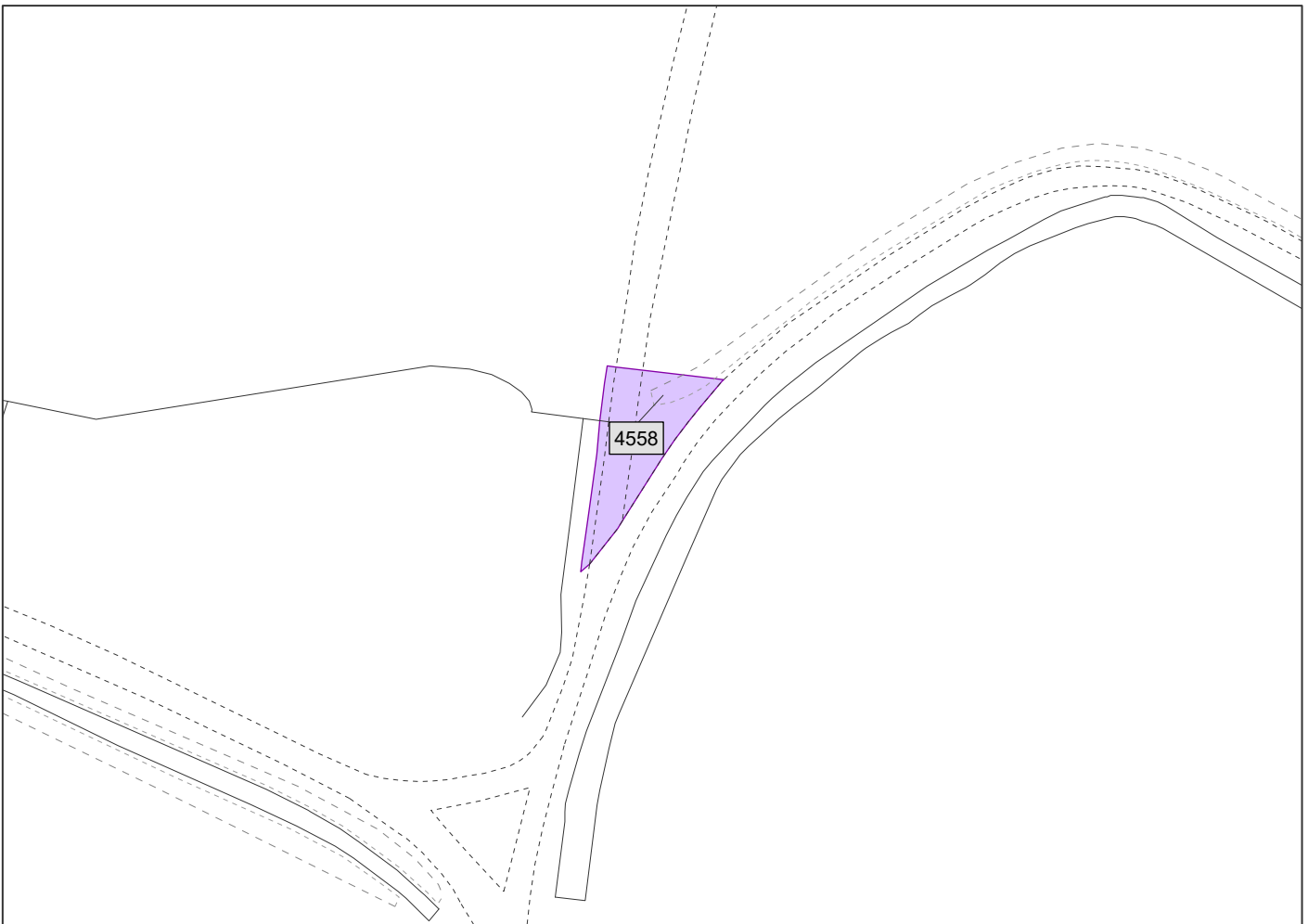
NGET will be submitting an application to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero for consent under Section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 and deemed planning permission under Section 90(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, for the installation of 0.9km of overhead line and removal of 0.8km of existing overhead line along the 2WS line at Weston Marsh ('S37 2WS Overhead Line Works'). The S37 2WS Overhead Line Works are proposed to connect into a new 400kV Air Insulated Substation (AIS) at Weston Marsh ('Weston Marsh Substation A').

As part of the process for the application, we must take reasonable steps to identify all freeholders, leaseholders (over 7 years) and agricultural tenants who may be affected by the application.
