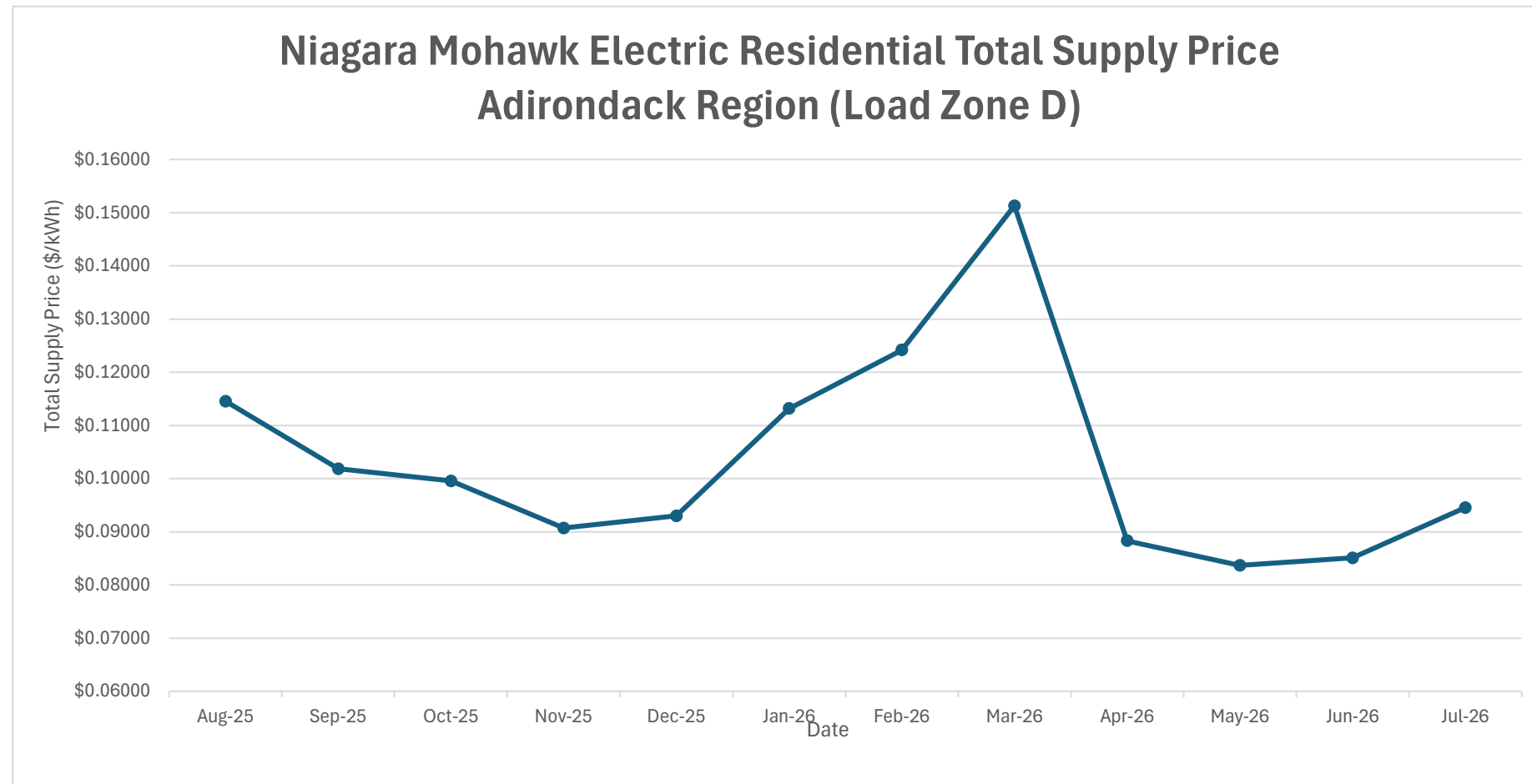

Definition of Terms

Zone = Applicable geographic zone for Supply pricing; may be found on customer's bill, left hand side of page 2

Zonal Supply Rate - Market price for electricity Supply specific to each zone

Electricity Supply Reconciliation Rate- a charge or credit on your bill that reconciles the cost of Electricity Supply for the applicable zone

Clean Energy Standard Supply Rate - Program costs for the New York Clean Energy Standard for supply.

Merchant Function Charge - Allows National Grid to recover the costs providing Supply Service to its customers
