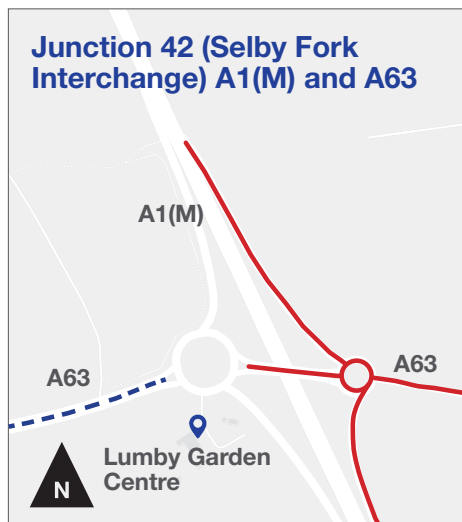


The Great Grid Upgrade

Overnight road closures: Junction 42 (Selby Fork Interchange) A1(M) and A63

- Saturday 22 August 2026
- Saturday 5 September 2026

We're upgrading the electricity network and need to carry out essential work on overhead lines near Junction 42 of the A1(M) (also known as the Selby Fork Interchange) and the A63.

To keep our workforce, road users and local communities safe while this work takes place, we will need to close parts of the road network. They will take place overnight to minimise disruption.

The closures will be in place, between **7pm and 6am** on:

- **Saturday 22 August 2026**
- **Saturday 5 September 2026**

The closures will include:

- **A full closure of Junction 42 for southbound traffic on the A1(M).** Drivers will not be able to leave or join the A1(M) southbound at Junction 42
- **A partial closure for northbound traffic approaching Junction 42 from the A1.** Vehicles will only be able to turn left onto the A63
- **A closure of the A63 between Junction 42 A1(M) and the A162 Monk Fryston roundabout.** Strictly access only. Vehicles needing access will need to travel from the Monk Fryston roundabout side of the closure.

Yorkshire GREEN is a £400 million project being delivered by National Grid to upgrade the UK's electricity network.

We appreciate that road closures can be disruptive and would like to thank you for your patience and understanding while we carry out this important work.

Please be aware that the dates and times of these closures are subject to change.
