

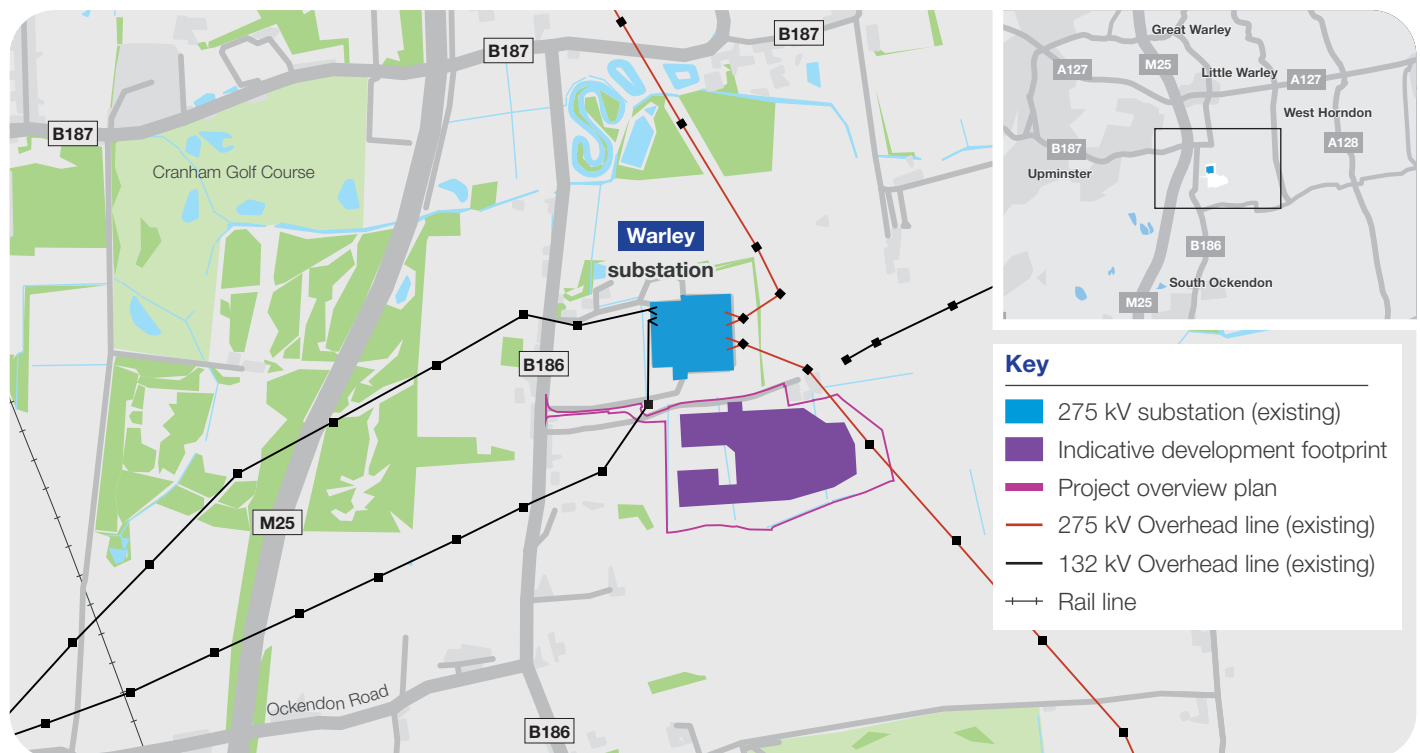
Proposals for Warley replacement substation

Opportunity to have your say

National Grid is developing plans to build a replacement electricity substation on land bordering our existing substation near Warley.

This new development at Warley is needed because the existing substation in the area is coming towards the end of its useful life. In addition, network upgrades and reinforcement are required in the area, and there is demand for new connections to the network.

Before we submit a planning application towards the end of 2026, we are inviting the local community to get involved through a public consultation. Your views will help shape our plans and the positive legacy we hope to leave for the community.



The public consultation on our proposals will run from 21 September to 16 October 2026.

When: Wednesday 30 Sept 2026, 1:00pm-6:00pm

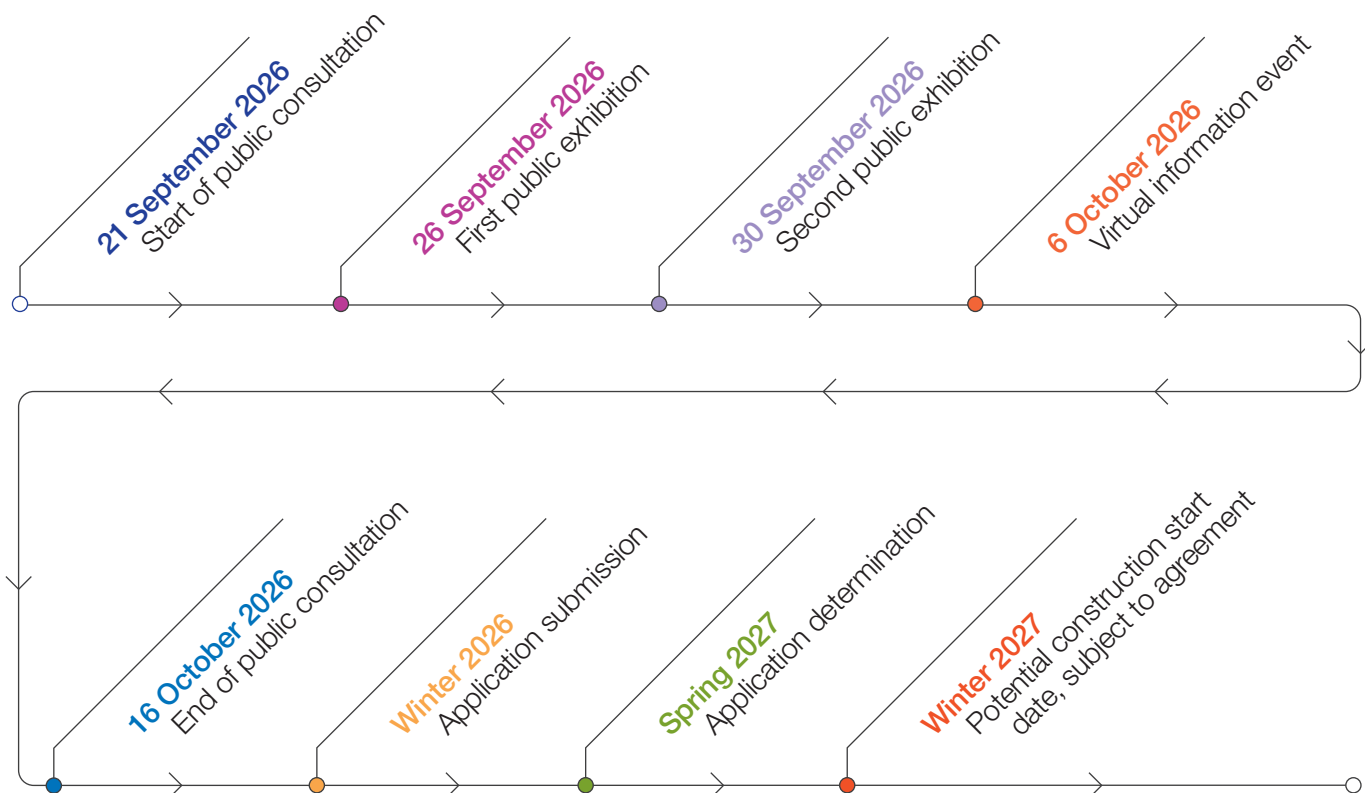
At these events, we will share details of our proposals and offer you a chance to provide feedback. Please drop in at any point and team members will be available to answer your questions.
