How we are consulting with the community



What are we proposing?

As part of The Great Grid Upgrade, the largest overhaul of the electricity grid in generations, we are proposing to build new electricity infrastructure and upgrade parts of the existing network. This would help move energy from where it is produced to where it is needed across Lincolnshire and the wider East Midlands.

With electricity demand set to more than double by 2050, our proposals would help deliver secure, cleaner and more affordable home-grown energy from where it is generated to where it is needed.

This would create a stronger, more reliable network for schools, hospitals and businesses in the region.

We want to hear from communities, business and organisations along the proposed route. This second stage of consultation is an opportunity to find out more about the proposals, speak with the project team and share feedback before our plans are developed further.

Our proposals include:



New overhead line

Approximately 60 km of new overhead line from Weston Marsh in Lincolnshire to near Wartonaby in Leicestershire.



Two new substations

- **WMEL-A** near Corby Glen, Lincolnshire
- **WMEL-B** near Wartonaby, Leicestershire



Upgrading the existing line

Upgrading approximately 66 km of the existing overhead line from WMEL-B substation down to the existing Grendon substation in Northamptonshire.

The Stage 2 Consultation will run from **Tuesday 8 September to Tuesday 3 November 2026**.

All responses must be received by **11.59pm on Tuesday 3 November 2026**.

Your feedback will help us to:

- understand local issues, concerns and priorities
- refine and improve our proposals where appropriate
- develop measures to avoid, reduce or manage potential impacts
- ensure local knowledge and community feedback are considered as the project develops.
