- Winter Outlook Report – Publication shortly thereafter

## Some Examples of Feedback Received

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- Imports expected from continental interconnectors, but demand in France more sensitive to temperature than GB demand
- Request clarification of demand definition
- Request more information on small embedded generation
- Capacity Assessment and UK Future Energy Scenarios interaction
- ...

# Demand and Interconnectors


## Changes for this year's Outlook Report

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- Based on Transmission System Demand
- Included Average Cold Spell Demand in margin calculation
- Estimated effect of unmetered embedded generation offset from all demand forecasts in all timescales
- Look at specific Interconnector scenarios, rather than expressing Interconnectors as a range of outputs
- Minor updates to margin calculation methodology
- Increased emphasis on sources of variability
