OVERHEAD LINE WORKS OFF THE A131/WORKS TO LINE 4YL AND PCB

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Grid Electricity Transmission plc (Registered Office: 1 - 3 Strand, London, WC2N 5EH) has submitted to the Secretary of State for the Department of Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy an application for consent under section 37 of the Electricity Act 1989 and deemed planning permission under section 90(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 for the following overhead line works:

- the temporary diversion of the existing 400kV overhead line (4YL Line) for a length of approximately 700 metres between existing pylons 4YL80 and 4YL82, which would include the construction of one temporary pylon with a height of between approximately 44 metres and 48 metres above ground level and which would be in place for up to a year (Grid Reference: E584602/N237084 to E583919/N237044, spanning east to west); and
- air insulated conductors, approximately 15 metres in length forming part of a new 132kV cable sealing end platform pylon (PCB Line) (Grid Reference: E584287/N236431).

The overhead line works are required to facilitate the construction and operation of a proposed grid supply point substation at *land adjacent to Butlers Wood and Waldergrave Wood, West Of A131 (in the parishes of Bulmer And Twinstead) Sudbury Road, Bulmer, Essex,* in connection with the proposed reinforcement of the 400kV transmission network between Bramford Substation in Suffolk and Twinstead Tee in Essex. An application for full planning permission for the proposed grid supply point substation is currently under determination with Braintree District Council (application reference number: 22/01147/FUL).
