National Grid update

- We are continuing discussions about our substation.
- We are aiming to finalise the designs this month and will submit them to Lambeth Council for Prior Approval (*Prior Approval is a formal submission to your local planning authority and the purpose of it is to seek confirmation that specified parts of a development are acceptable, before work can commence.*)
- Once submitted to the Council, they will validate the application and then start their own consultation. We will share details about this in due course.
- The application should be determined within eight weeks, depending on any outstanding queries. We will work with the council to resolve these.
