Footpaths and roads affected by essential refurbishment works



Keeping the public and our teams safe is our top priority. While we refurbish the overhead electricity line between Stanah and Hambleton Moss Side, we need to temporarily close some footpaths and use traffic management measures.

We'll display signs in advance of any closures and keep the local community informed about any upcoming changes or traffic diversions.

Temporary footpath closures and road impacts

A588, north of Hambleton

- 8 20 January and 10 24 February 2025: Two-way temporary traffic lights near Schofield Steel.
- **11 March 13 July 2025:** Temporary speed reduction from 50mph to 30mph between Queensland Country Park and the junction with Sower Carr Lane.

Cutts Lane, Hambleton Moss Side

• 6 – 20 January 2025: We'll narrow the road so we can segregate an access route to the pylons.

Ghants Lane, Hambleton Moss Side

• 7 – 10 January 2025: Temporary two-way traffic lights.

Stanah Road, Stanah

• 22 – 31 January 2025: Temporary two-way traffic lights near the junction off River Road.

Wardley's Lane, Hambleton

- **24 February 8 March 2025:** Managed closure, with road access granted to residents and business owners.
- March August 2025: Occasional 15-minute closures using stop and go traffic boards while we coordinate deliveries to the site.
- 13 March 13 July 2025: One-way system with entry permitted from the south and exit via New Road.

Planned footpath closures

North of Hambleton

• **7 April – 13 July 2025:** Closure of both footpaths. We'll install signage near the route to indicate closed areas.



Hambleton Moss Side

• **6 January – 19 July 2025:** Footpath closure from Cutts Lane to Turkey Street. We'll install signage near the route to indicate closed areas.



Hambleton Moss Side

• **7 April – 13 July 2025:** Footpath closures from Ghants Lane and Sower Carr to Arthurs Lane, Hambleton. We'll install signage near the route to indicate closed areas.



Stanah

• **31 March – 13 July 2025:** Footpath closure on a section south of Stanah House Caravan Park. We'll install signage near the route to indicate closed areas.



Planned footpath closures

Stanah

• **20 April – 20 June 2025:** Occasional short term closures on Stanah Tramper Trail footpath, between pylon VF67 and the River Wyre in Wyre Estuary Country Park. We'll install signage near the route to indicate closed areas.
