



Carbon Capture & Storage (CCS)

- Ofgem published a consultation on a proposal by National Grid to use a section of the gas transmission network for the transport of carbon dioxide gas from the Longannet power station up to the North Sea.
- Consultation closes 4 June.

Charging methodology from BBL

- Ofgem recently approved a charging methodology from BBL, which allows them to put in place a service for non-physical interruptible reverse flow products from GB to the Netherlands. Capacity will be auctioned in quarterly, monthly and daily blocks.
- We expect the service to be operational in time for this winter.

Quarterly System Entry Capacity (QSEC)

- The recent QSEC resulted in a signal for incremental capacity at Barrow. NGG proposed meeting this requirement through entry capacity substitution, using capacity from Teesside on a straight 1:1 transfer, and Ofgem approved the proposal.

Removal of NTS Daily Entry Capacity Reserve Price Discounts

- NGG has submitted a charging methodology modification proposal, GCM-19, which proposes to remove the requirement for NGG to offer capacity in a clearing auction.
- Related UNC modifications would restrict the availability of Use-It-Or-Lose-It capacity to those ASEPs where more than 90% of baseline has sold out.
- Ofgem has confirmed that it will issue an Impact Assessment on these proposals (estimated issue date w/c 7 June).
