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- A Commercial Gas Entry service has been developed by National Grid & Gaslink, in agreement with regulators.
- UNC Mod 0352 was approved by Ofgem with an implementation date of 4th October 2011.

Capacity

- Interruptible Capacity shall be offered by National Grid using the Daily Interruptible System Entry capacity Auction (DISEC)
 - Effective from Gas Day 6th October.
- A new ASEP of Moffat (MF) has been added to Gemini to allow this.
- The capacity offered will be discretionary.
