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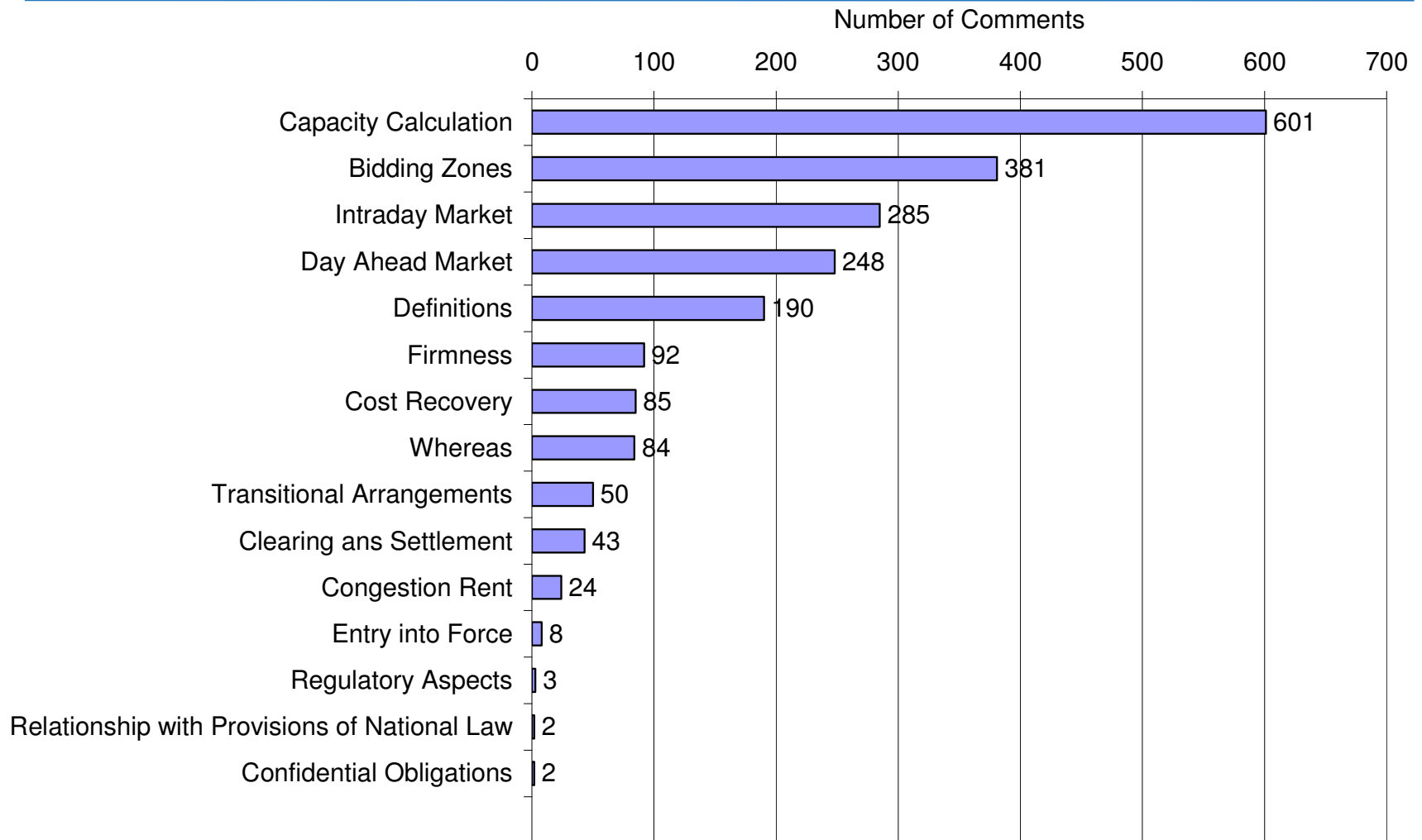

Consultation Feedback

- The formal consultation on the CACM network code has now closed
- Comments are being reviewed by the drafting team
- Over 2000 comments received from ~30 respondents using the Web-based tool
 - 95% of queries were fundamental; 5% were editorial
 - 75% were technical; 25% legal

- Drafting team are reviewing comments received
- Comments will either:
 - result in a modification to the code, or
 - will be rejected.
- In **both cases 'justification'** will be published by ENTSO-E
- Code due to be submitted to ACER, End Sept 2013
- Due to enter comitology, January 2013
