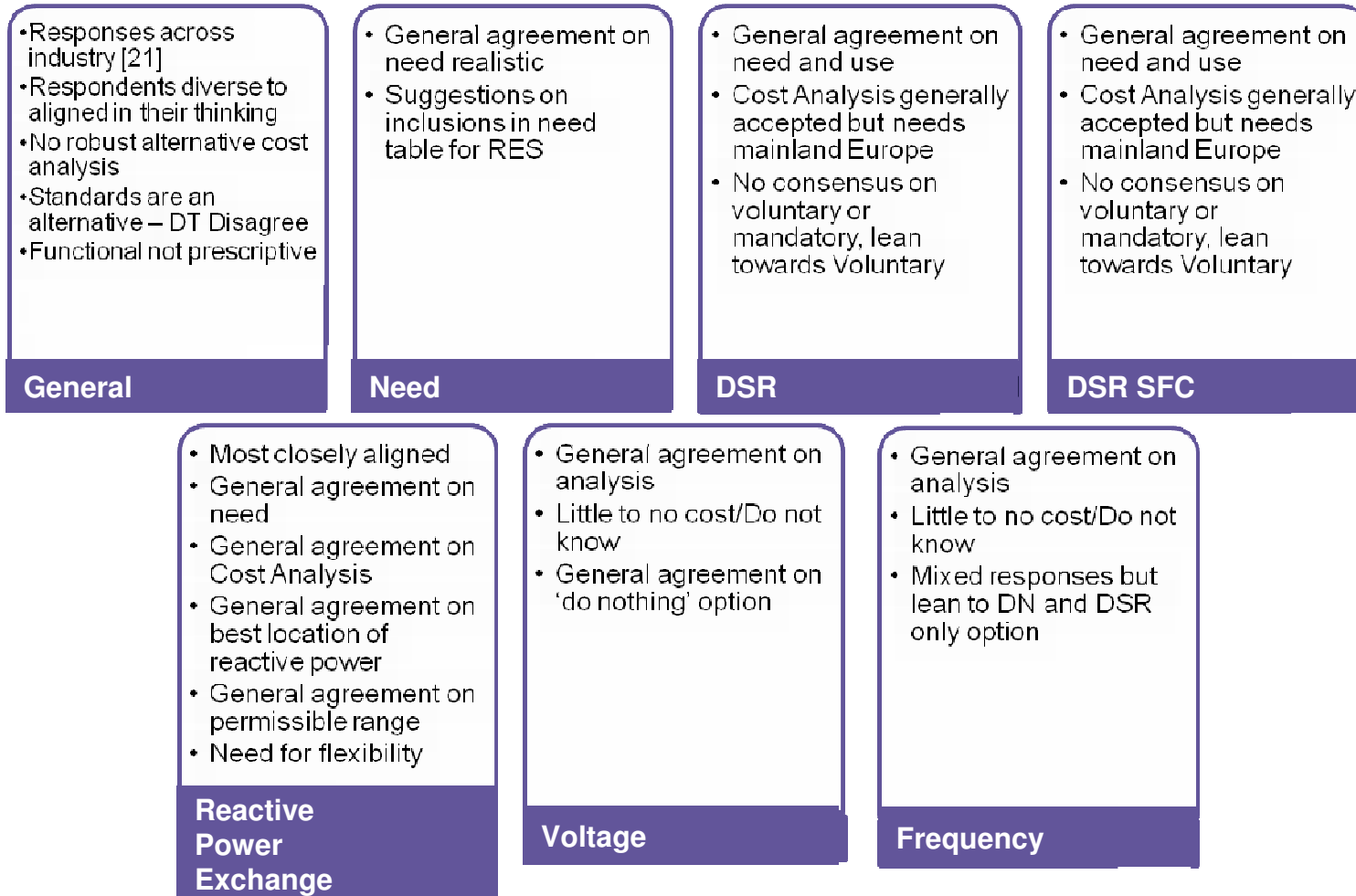

- This is the high-level summary of the Call for Evidence Responses produced by ENTOS-E
- The analysis is divided across the individual areas outlined in the Call for Evidence
- Further detail will be provided in the consultation pack of the Formal Consultation.

Call for Evidence – Responses Breakdown

- 21 organisations (7 UK) provided feedback:
 - Energy suppliers, DSOs, industry customers, DSR providers & manufactures of domestic appliances.
- UK organisations / companies:
 - ENW, SPD, UKPN, WPD, EDF Energy, Renewable UK & SSE Generation.
- Assessment of content:
 - Mixed responses from full support to out-right rejection.
 - No alternative CBAs provided or significant alternative data.

Key Activities

- ENTSO-E is now finalising the code prior to issue for Formal Consultation:
- Consultation scheduled to run from 30 June – 3 September
