Status Update

- ENTSO-E has been revising the CACM Network Code since the Public Consultation closed on 23 May 2012
 - Including stakeholder workshops 7 and 29 August
- The Network Code is now substantially complete – undergoing final governance approval in ENTSO-E
- Due for submission to ACER 30 September

Changes to the Network Code

- Significant changes to text to provide clarity, tighten wording and align with Governance Guidelines
- We do not believe high-level principles have changed from the consultation version
- New section on sharing of costs between TSOs for cross-border redispatch; but methodology to be defined later
- Changes in requirement to provide data at D-2, to requiring data at a time to be determined after the Network Code is implemented

Next steps

- ACER review of Network Code
 - 3 months to provide reasoned opinion as to whether the Network Code is in line with the Framework Guideline:
 - October – December 2012
 - ACER may consult relevant stakeholders
 - Opinion due by end of December 2012
