Rationale

- Regulation 714/2009 Article 15 requires publication of data on
 - Network availability
 - Generation capacity
 - Cross-border interconnector capacity
 - Load
 - Unavailability (planned and unplanned)
- Availability of data underpins decisions on production, consumption and trading
- EC-led drafting

Key Points & Timetable

- Minimum common set of data that needs to be available to market participants
- Central collection and publication of data
- Role for ENTSO-E
 - Provision of common transparency platform
 - 'Manual of procedures' specifying details and format for submission of data
- Regulation expected to come into force ~ May/June '13
- Data to be available 18 months after Regulation comes into force (i.e. Dec 2014??)

Implementation issues

- Opportunity to test implementation process ahead of Network Codes
- Overlap with definitions & data requirements from other Network Codes; similarity to REMIT
- Agree data flows & potential data provider
- Map existing data flows and identify gaps
- GB Code changes
- IT system changes
- Discussions with Ofgem 19 February
- Proposals to Imbalance Settlement Group 26 February
