



ENTSO-E Stakeholder Engagement

- Article 2.2 of draft Transparency Guidelines requires consultation on data definitions
- To be attended by the six main European stakeholder associations
- Stakeholder meetings around Q1/Q2 2012
- All relevant documents to be posted on the ENTSO-E website
 - Interested parties can provide comments



Obligation on Data Owners

Article 3.1 of draft Transparency Guidelines:

"TSOs, electricity generators, electricity consumption units and DSOs who are the primary owners* of the data shall submit all information and data specified in these guidelines to the data providers* to enable publication according to the requirements set out in these guidelines."


Rationale for Potential Solution
