

Summary

- European Codes will supersede GB Codes
 - First 9 Network Codes become EU Law in 2014
 - Codes have varying compliance periods (typically 2014-16)
- Significant workload over the next few years to develop, apply and implement Codes
- Significant changes to GB Operations and Market
- Viewed by ENTSO-E as facets of a a single deliverable
- Facilitates move to non-carbon generation
