

EU Harmonisation of Maintenance Publications at Interconnections Points 2016-2017

European Regulation EC 715/2009 puts an obligation on Transmission System Operators (TSOs) to publish Maintenance Information.

Information in this published document covers the impact of NTS maintenance on interconnector capacity, based on the most up to date maintenance information available. We work closely with our customers to ensure minimum impact to supply and endeavour to meet our firm entry and exit obligations.

Please note that the figures published are on our best view of the maintenance schedule to date. The impact on firm obligations through revisions to any scheduled maintenance are reviewed monthly and published 42 days in advance of the maintenance activity occurring.

This document only includes the impact of maintenance activities on the NTS, which are to be undertaken by National Grid NTS.
