The next step is to bring the Initial Modification Report to the Panel for approval before it is sent out to Industry Consultation. CM059 was presented at the September 2017 STC Panel meeting, the Panel agreed that this modification should continue to proceed as a Self- Governance Modification. The Panel approved the draft initial modification report; this was then published for industry consultation for 15 working days. One response was received supporting the modification. On 20 October the draft final modification report was issued to the industry and Authority for 5 working days, no responses were received. The draft final modification report will be submitted to Panel in November. CM059 was implemented into the STC on 22 December 2017.
