

# Network Emergency Management Team (NEMT) Participation Requirements

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During the emergency exercise, the NEMT will:

- Initiate Exercise Yield by issuing an exercise start pro forma, detailing the incident and situational update. The commercial actions taken will be based on assumptions used during the preceding Commercial Strategy exercise.
- Contact the Oil and Gas Authority (OGA) to request the authorisation of the Gas Availability Status (G.A.S) Report and contact the Terminal and LNG Operators to request potential supply availability and delivery times.
- Contact the Storage Operators and request storage supply availability and delivery times.
- Collate the G.A.S report and Storage report submissions and participate in the (OGA) Emergency Response Team (ERT) supply availability communications.
- Contact the UK Distribution Network Operators and Irish Interconnector Operator to request detailed demand breakdowns.
- Formulate an emergency strategy based on the supply and demand data gathering and seek approval from the NEC of the emergency strategy.
- Communicate all supply increases, and demand reduction instructions including NTS directly connected loads to the relevant companies for cooperation of the NEC emergency strategy.
- Convene at National Grid's offices in Warwick during the exercise.
