Operational Summary (HK)	 HK covered an operational summary of the start of the summer (01/04/2018 to 31/05/2018). Slides available in PDF pack: Higher than normal demand at the beginning of the summer, which has now dropped to normal summer demand LDZ Demand has followed a similar pattern, starting high, and returning to more normal levels IUK Exports have been relatively low. Supply from UKCS and Norway has been much more variable this year, as demonstrated by larger range in slide chart Supply from LNG has reduced significantly compared to last year, which is likely due to relatively high prices in Asian markets More gas has been supplied from the south, in line with the trend seen in winter Action NG to share link to full pack for Operational Data. GNI Presentation (Wayne Mullins)	 WM provided an overview of Gas Networks Ireland history + current operation: GNI operates Transmission + Distribution networks in Ireland, provides all new customer connections, manages a 24 hour emergency response service, and is expanding into new areas such as renewable gas and smart metering. Corrib gas supplies are gradually decreasing, putter greater emphasis on supplies from Moffat Large proportion of gas used for power generation compared with National Grid Significant challenge for GNI to balance on a daily basis, with imbalance charges increased 11 Shippers currently registered for trading through Irish Balancing Point 	
Shrinkage Incentive (GC)	GC Gave an overview of Gas Shrinkage: - 3 components of shrinkage: Compressor Fuel Use, Unaccounted for Gas, and Calorific Value Shrinkage - Outturn cost of £70-80 million per year recharged through commodity charges - 2017/18 total volume = 3818 GWh (0.4% of annual system demand)
