

Terminal Operators including LNG Importation Terminals Participation Requirements

The Terminal Operators including LNG importation terminal operators will be requested to provide their gas availability and delivery times and Situation Reports details via the OAG web portal system.

Data provided in the Gas Availability Status (G.A.S) Report and Situation Reports (Sitrep) should be based upon actual on the day data rather than pre-determined exercise data.

Terminal Group Leaders will also be requested to support and participate in Terminal Group Leader teleconference discussions.

The NEMT will issue flow direction instructions pro formas to Terminals and LNG Operators during stage 2 of the Network Gas Supply Emergency, Shippers will receive copies of all notifications for supply directions.

National Grid will inform the Terminal of the emergency and any direction to amend flow. Upon being informed of an emergency, the recipient must brief all relevant personnel as to the existence and nature of the emergency.

It is the Terminal's responsibility to inform their Shipper/agent or commercial trading desk of gas flow amendment to support the NEC instructions.

Business as usual operational communications with the GNCC should be maintained throughout the course of the exercise even following the mobilisation of the Terminal Group Leaders for participation of the upstream telephone conferences.
