OPERATING MARGINS ("OM") – INVITATION TO TENDER

This Invitation to Tender is made in respect of National Grid Gas plc's latest OM procurement exercise.

OM Requirement

Tenders are invited from Storage, LNG Importation with Storage, or Demand Reduction to meet the 2022/23 forecast OM requirement. The initial forecast requirement is **874 GWh**, which includes locational requirements in the South West and South East.

Changes for the 2022/23 Tender

There are two important changes that participants should note for the 2022/23 tender:

1. Tender pack rationalisation. All three tender packs have been rationalised such that only one tender pack per site is required. Within each of the tender packs, there are now multiple sheets which can be used should a tenderer wish to submit alternate proposal(s).

For Tender Pack 1 (Gas Capacity), there are two sheets (A and B), Tenders may wish to use Sheet B to re-offer some of all of the volume in Sheet A, but with a different tranche structure as per part 5 of Tender Pack 1.

For Tender Packs 2 and 3 (Gas Delivery – LNG and Demand Reduction), there are three sheets (A, B and C). Tenderers may wish to use Sheet B to re-offer some or all of the volume in Sheet A, but with a different tranche structure (LNG), and a different volume (Demand reduction) for example Sheet A may be for a full power station turndown, whilst Sheet B may be for a partial turndown. For these tender packs we are also introducing a new option for bidders to offer a 'Winter only' service, as per point (2) below.

 For the Gas Delivery Contracts there is an additional option to provide a 'Winter only' tender submission for 2022/23. Tenderers may submit a proposal covering only the last seven months of the traditional OM contract year, i.e. for the period 01/10/2022 – 30/04/2023. Should tenderers wish to provide a proposal for this, they should fill out 'Sheet C' of either Tender Pack 2 (LNG) or Tender Pack 3 (Demand Reduction).

Please note, for ALL tender packs, National Grid will consider accepting volumes from **ONE** of Sheets A or B (Tender Pack 1), or Sheets A, B or C (Tender Packs 2 and 3).

E-tendering

We shall be using the electronic portal ARIBA for the submission of tenders. We encourage you to register on Ariba if you do not have an account and familiarise yourself with the portal by Friday 7th January 2022 in order for you to gain access and prepare for tender submission. Alternative methods of tender submission are not allowed.
